Artur Hazelius was born in Stockholm in 1833 and died at Skansen in 1901. In founding Skansen, in 1891, he created the world's first open-air museum. The creation of Skansen is related to the romantic ideas and the patriotic spirit of the latter part the nineteenth century, both of which strongly influenced Hazelius. Skansen is the oldest open-air museum in the world and nowhere else in Sweden can you experience anything as genuinely Swedish as you can at Skansen: from the magnificent settings among the buildings and farms and the animal life in the zoo, to the captivating views across Stockholm.

At Skansen we will have afternoon coffee with a traditional Swedish cinnamon bun.

The tour also includes a panorama tour of the city.
