

2012 Award of the Jean-Marie Delwart Foundation in Higher Olfactory Processing

In 2012 The Jean-Marie Delwart Foundation awards a Prize for original, high impact work in the field of Higher Olfactory Processing.

The Prize amounts to US\$10,000.

Candidates may apply, or may be nominated by a specialist in the field or by an Academic Institution. In all cases an introductory letter, a detailed CV, and a complete list of publications should be provided. Reprints, books and/or anything considered relevant could be added to this set. In addition a short CV (1p), a description of the main contributions to the field of higher olfactory processing (2p) and a list of the ten most relevant publications should be provided.
