Time to visit the Palace!

The Drottningholm Palace is on UNESCO's World Heritage list. It is the most well-preserved royal castle built in the 17th century in Sweden and at the same time it is representative of all European architecture for the period.

The magnificent palace and gardens makes a visit to Drottningholm a unique experience. Influenced by French prototype, the palace was built by architect Nicodemus Tessin the Elder by commission of Queen Hedvig Eleonora. Since then, a number of royalties have left their mark on the palace.

The Palace is the present Royal Family's permanent residence. The rooms in the southern wing of the palace are reserved for this purpose. The rest of the palace and grounds are open to the public year round.

Return transfer is by coach.

Price includes; English speaking guide (max 3 hrs), boat to Drottningholm, transfer from Drottningholm to the city with modern sightseeing coach, visit to the Drottningholm Palace, Coffee and cake.
